

AGC Guidelines for Worship Services Under “Safer at Home: Phase Three”

The following are guidelines for on-campus services under “Safer at Home: Phase Three” in compliance with the Virginia Department of Health, which went into effect on July 1, 2020.

WHAT AGC WILL DO

- We will create 6 feet of space between rows of seats in our sanctuary.
- We will ensure there are at least 3 empty seats between families seated on same row.
- We will clean and disinfect frequently contacted surfaces prior to and following services.
- We will post signage at all entrances that provide public health reminders.
- We will have ushers wearing gloves and masks to open exterior & interior doors.

WHAT ATTENDERS NEED TO DO

Before coming to an AGC Service, the following are required:

- **Take the temperature of everyone planning to come to AGC.** If anyone in your household has a fever, has any other symptom of Covid-19 or has been exposed to the Covid-19 virus within the past 14 days, please stay home and enjoy our service online. **If you do not take your temperature before coming to church, AGC is prepared to take it when you arrive.**
- Use the restroom before you leave home to minimize contact with bathroom facilities. In the event that restrooms are needed, there will be a limit of 2 persons in a restroom at a time.
- Face masks ARE required for adults and children ages 6 and older.
- Due to limited supplies, please bring your own hand sanitizer.
- Do not arrive before 10:15am on Sunday mornings or 6:30pm on Wednesday evenings.
- Those age 65 and older are welcome to worship with us in person at their own discretion.
- If you are in the At-Risk category (those with suppressed immune systems, those with chronic respiratory illnesses, etc.) please stay home and enjoy our services online.
- Continue to use our online giving option to help reduce the handling of materials by our bookkeeper.

When you arrive at AGC, please do the following:

- You will be asked to verify compliance with the above-mentioned personal protocols.
- Limit physical touches. Our ushers will open doors for you.
- Do not pass anything one to another.
- Sit together with those of your direct household, keeping a 3-chair space between households.
- Do not shake hands, fist bump or hug. Respect the 6-foot social distancing requirement.
