Read 1 Timothy 2:7-15 in at least the following three translations. Write down every question you have about this passage.

KJV

<sup>8</sup> I will therefore that men pray every where, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and doubting.

<sup>9</sup> In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with shamefacedness and sobriety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array;

<sup>10</sup> But (which becometh women professing godliness) with good works.

<sup>11</sup> Let the woman learn in silence with all subjection.

<sup>12</sup> But I suffer not a woman to teach, nor to usurp authority over the man, but to be in silence.

<sup>13</sup> For Adam was first formed, then Eve.

<sup>14</sup> And Adam was not deceived, but the woman being deceived was in the transgression.

<sup>15</sup> Notwithstanding she shall be saved in childbearing, if they continue in faith and charity and holiness with sobriety.

ESV

<sup>8</sup> I desire then that in every place the men should pray, lifting holy hands without anger or quarreling;

<sup>9</sup> likewise also that women should adorn themselves in respectable apparel, with modesty and self-control, not with braided hair and gold or pearls or costly attire,

<sup>10</sup> but with what is proper for women who profess godliness-- with good works.

<sup>11</sup> Let a woman learn quietly with all submissiveness.

<sup>12</sup> I do not permit a woman to teach or to exercise authority over a man; rather, she is to remain quiet.

<sup>13</sup> For Adam was formed first, then Eve;

<sup>14</sup> and Adam was not deceived, but the woman was deceived and became a transgressor.

<sup>15</sup> Yet she will be saved through childbearing-- if they continue in faith and love and holiness, with self-control.

NIV

<sup>8</sup> I want men everywhere to lift up holy hands in prayer, without anger or disputing.

<sup>9</sup> I also want women to dress modestly, with decency and propriety, not with braided hair or gold or pearls or expensive clothes,

<sup>10</sup> but with good deeds, appropriate for women who profess to worship God.

<sup>11</sup> A woman should learn in quietness and full submission.

<sup>12</sup> I do not permit a woman to teach or to have authority over a man; she must be silent.

<sup>13</sup> For Adam was formed first, then Eve.

<sup>14</sup> And Adam was not the one deceived; it was the woman who was deceived and became a sinner.

<sup>15</sup> But women will be saved through childbearing--if they continue in faith, love and holiness with propriety.
