Children:

Youth:

Youth has been slow going. We have had one meeting so far and it looks like April 11th will not have a meeting either. It's hard getting them back into the building when we've been gone for so long. I am hoping that as Sunday School starts again the attendance will increase.

For right now I have no plans for youth for the Summer. With us not meeting and youth attendance being so low I am not sure what our Summer is going to look like.

**For right now I am NOT starting back up on Wednesday nights for Youth OR children. I have sent out a survey to all of my families and had very little response. The response that I did get was negative towards starting back on Wednesdays. I also have very few (maybe 2 people) that have volunteered to help on Wednesday nights again. So for the foreseeable future we will not have a Wednesday night service. I am hopeful that as things start going back to normal our children and youth participation goes up.

The backpack program is thriving. I am filling bags up to the very top each week. Donations are steady and we have an abundance of food. The only thing I am low on is soup. But I am able to make that up with other items so I am not worried.

I will be on vacation June 19-27, 2021. I have already scheduled volunteers to cover both Sundays.

I will be gone again in July but I will get those dates to you at a later time.
