Sanctuary Project Update:

The Technology and Building/Ground committees have been very busy with the sanctuary and technology upgrades. Most of the work is hidden, rewiring all the campus buildings with Cat6 wiring, installing Wi-Fi access points, switches, patch panels, multiplexers, HDMI cables and converters, microphone and speaker wiring, installing new receptacles, electrical conduit, stage pocket receptacles, new telephones, computer connections, jack connections and 75" TV's.

All you really see out of all this are three new TV's. Over 3600 feet of wire was installed in difficult places to get to and an estimated 47 devices wired to the Cat6 wire backbone.

We now have one Wi-Fi network replacing three networks we had.

We have more cosmetic things to do and we'll start the sanctuary stage renovations in January which is reducing the number of floor levels and carpeting the stage.

We are grateful for the many volunteers for working on Saturdays for two months and with more work yet to do.

We also ask for your patience as the AV team is learning how to operate new software for displaying the TV screens, a new digital soundboard to improve our sound, and a new way to live stream the service. All these things are new to the AV team, and we may have a glitch or two over the next few weeks.
