### Security Plan Update:

As you all know the deacons have security plans and teams in place to make our campus more safe and secure. In addition to the newsletter updates you will be getting this month about our security system we want to let everyone know this most recent update.

Security planning includes any physical threats, weather threats and medical events or emergencies. Each of our security alarm key pads have been updated to include activating panic alarm buttons, POLICE, FIRE AND MEDICAL emergencies. In any medical event or emergency your deacons and certain members of our church who have advanced medical training have agreed to also respond. First, 911 will be immediately notified if there is a medical emergency and anyone can seek assistance for any medical situation from the below volunteers who have advance medical training and have volunteered to help if called upon. We thank each of this professional for volunteering and they will be a great value in serving our members if the need arises.
