Your Mission Action Committee is happy to announce that Cindy Marlowe and Allison Jenkins will provide vaccines and immunizations on **Saturday, October 7 from 9am to 3pm** in our FLC. Put that date in your calendar and we will have a sign-up sheet on the trophy case two weeks prior for your convenience. It is by appointment only so you will need to sign up in advance in order to have the vaccines/immunizations available that you are requesting. Please include all the required contact information on the sign-up list. Covid vaccines are not confirmed yet but are expected to be available so sign up for the Covid vaccine if you want one.

You will need your insurance information available and be prepared to pay your copay if your insurance provider requires a co-pay.

Vaccines/Immunizations available are Flu, Pneumonia, Tetanus, Shingles, Hepatitis A/B, RSV and RSV 60+ (and older). Also, Covid (if available) but sign up for Covid as it may be last minute before we know for sure.

We do have a limited number of times available, but we do encourage our church members to encourage any of your family members or friends to sign up as well. So sign up early! Obviously, we do need commitment from those who sign up to be present at the appointed time to minimize any waiting or disruption.

Community Health Assessment

From Katie Harris, GCCBA:

Today, September 1, is the kickoff day for the 2023 Cleveland County Community Health Assessment to identify current and emerging health issues in Cleveland County. Leadership for the assessment is provided by the Cleveland County Health Department as part of the local health department accreditation process and also as part of the Consolidated Agreement with the NC Division of Public Health. Conducting a community survey is part of the assessment process. This year's survey was developed by a Core Oversight Committee composed of community representatives and meets the standard requirements of the Division of Public Health. Survey responses are confidential. Survey results will be compiled into a document set for publication in early 2024.

There are two ways to participate in the survey: first, you may choose to complete the survey electronically by going to the following link:

or by completing a paper survey available at various sites throughout the county. We have also attached a PDF format for the paper survey should you choose to print one for yourself. The survey is open from September 1 through September 30, 2023.

Individuals who complete a survey are eligible to enter a drawing for incentive prizes which this year include a \$750 Amazon gift card, two \$500 Amazon gift cards and four \$250 Amazon gift cards. Winners will be chosen using a computer-generated random number computer program and will be notified on or about November 15, 2023.

We encourage your participation in this survey – we need to know what you think about the health of Cleveland County and about what needs to be done to improve the health status of residents. If you have questions or concerns about the survey, please contact Anne Short
