In the days following the resurrection, something unusual transpired in the lives of the disciples of Jesus. Frankly, the last days of Jesus' life were not award winning for the original twelve. Judas betrayed Jesus and took his life, while in the events that swirled around the cross found the other disciples hiding, fearful, and in the case of Peter, betraying Jesus just as grotesquely as did Judas. It was not a pretty sight.

But after the resurrection, things began to change. Cowards found their courage. Those with spiritual laryngitis began to speak. In fact, Peter and John could not be silenced. They testified and preached everywhere they could find a platform.
