

**COMMUNITY CHRISTIAN CHURCH OF FRANKFORT, IN**  
**STUDENT BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS (PLEASE SIGN)**

1. **The rule of thumb that we're aiming for: "...And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, giving thanks to God the Father" (Colossians 3:17a). If you can't do it in the name of Jesus, you don't need to do it!**
2. When transportation is involved in any youth activity, all students will ride in church vehicle(s) or designated vehicle(s). No student is allowed to drive during the activity, unless it has been approved by the leader.
3. Students are expected to comply with all instructions given by an adult leader.
4. Students are expected to respect church facilities. Should a student's actions cause damage or breakage, he/she will be held responsible for repair or replacement of the broken or damaged item.
5. When attending any church program or event, all students are expected to participate in those activities, not hang around outside the buildings, roaming the hallways, etc.
6. When attending any church program or event, all students are expected to be present for the entirety of the event, unless special arrangements have been made ahead of time between the adult leaders and that student's parents. No student is allowed to join an event already in progress or leave one early, unless prearranged with the leader.
7. When we return from an activity, we ask that parents pick up their students at the time stated. We try very hard both to accurately pinpoint our return times and to notify parents if we will not be back within a 10 minute time window before or after the designated time. We ask that parents be here to meet us when we arrive, rather than waiting at home for a phone call from the student.
8. Upon our return from any road trip, students are expected to help clean out the interior of the vehicle(s) before claiming their luggage and going home.
9. Because we want to maintain a positive, Christ-centered atmosphere at all of our youth ministry functions, we ask that students keep godliness and modesty in mind in their clothing choices.
  - Students should avoid revealing, distracting, and excessively tight clothing (i.e., short shorts, short skirts, bare midriffs, and underwear in plain sight). Clothing should not display any offensive messages or images.
  - Girls must wear modest swimsuits....no bikinis.
  - Guys must wear a shirt at all times unless swimming.
10. Portable entertainment such as CD players, MP3 players, video games, etc., are not to be brought to youth events or on youth trips unless otherwise stated by the adult leaders.
11. Cell phones are expected to be used in compliance with respectful standards. No student is allowed to use another student's cell phone. Personal cell phones are never to be used to call anyone except an adult leader or their parents or guardians. Cell phones must be silenced. No music, games, texting, or any other non-emergency use during youth events. They must be put away. Misuse of a cell phone will result in it being confiscated for the rest of the activity. Community Christian Church is not responsible for lost or stolen cell phones. (Please note that adult leaders have cell phones that students can use.)
12. Obviously, alcohol, tobacco, drugs, firearms, knives, foul language, inappropriate displays of affection, uncooperative attitudes, tractor-trailer rigs, bad haircuts, leisure suits, armadillos, tuna sandwiches, Yanni cd's, lightning rods, and/or life-size replicas of science fiction characters will not be permitted to be a part of any Community Christian Church youth function.
13. The adult leaders (Youth Coaches) at Community Christian Church reserve the right to dismiss or suspend from any activity any student who demonstrates an attitude of indifference to these guidelines. If the violation occurs during the course of an out-of-town event, dismissal may include sending the student home at the expense of his/her parent(s)/guardian(s).

We have read these guidelines. We agree to abide by them, and understand the consequences of not following them.
