## **Go Deep** (Galatians 6:1-5)

- 1. Do you know someone who has been hurt by the church instead of helped by the church? What caused the hurt?
- 2. We're not dealing with Jew vs Gentile or black vs white with the example of Rosa Parks... but do people who have failed feel like second class citizens in church? Why?
- 3. Read Romans 12:2 and Titus 3:5 What (if any) is the difference between "restoring" in Galatians 6 and "renewing" in Romans and Titus?
- 4. Does seeing the person needing restoration as a "brother or sister" change our perspective? Should it?
- 5. How spiritual do you have to be to help someone? To be a part of their restoring process?
- 6. Does walking "in cadence with the Spirit" feel rigid sometimes?
- 7. What's the opposite of spiritual in this text? Can that person help restore?
- 8. How many times should we help / restore someone?
- 9. Is there a time when we should stop attempting to restore?
- 10. What does it look like to be restored with gentleness? What would not being gentle do?
- 11. How can we at Lockwood be a church of restoration?
