Greetings,

We are contacting you to share information from the State of New Jersey that may be of interest to the members of your religious community.

Under a new law signed in July, the Division of Taxation has been authorized to implement a tax amnesty program, providing taxpayers with the opportunity to file past tax returns and/or pay back taxes along with only half of the interest due as of November 1, 2018.

The 2018 New Jersey Tax Amnesty begins November 15, 2018 and ends January 15, 2019.

Amnesty will only apply to outstanding tax filings or payments that are reportable on a tax return due on or after February 1, 2009, and prior to September 1, 2017.

We hope that you will be able to share this information with your congregants through your bulletins, newsletters or other channels. We have attached a flyer that you are welcome to reproduce and distribute as needed.
