## **Google Groups**

We use Google Groups to communicate regarding events, prayer needs, and information relevant to the entire church. Members are allowed to post and reply to topics, but the group is moderated, and we reserve the right to not approve messages that are inappropriate or otherwise outside the purpose and scope of the group.

Please do not use the group for:

- Fundraising
- Promotion of business and contracting services
- Political debate or discussion
- Topics that violate the privacy of another individual
- Any topic that otherwise violates the values and practices of Calvary Chapel

### **Church Social Media**

The church currently livestreams and posts content to Facebook, YouTube, Instagram, etc. We welcome engagement and discussion in these spaces, but we reserve the right to remove content that is not consistent with our values and practices.

#### **Individual Social Media Accounts**

The views and opinions expressed by individual staff, leaders, or members on their private social media accounts are their own and do not necessarily reflect the views of Calvary Chapel.
