A time to get, and a time to lose; a time to keep, and a time to cast away;

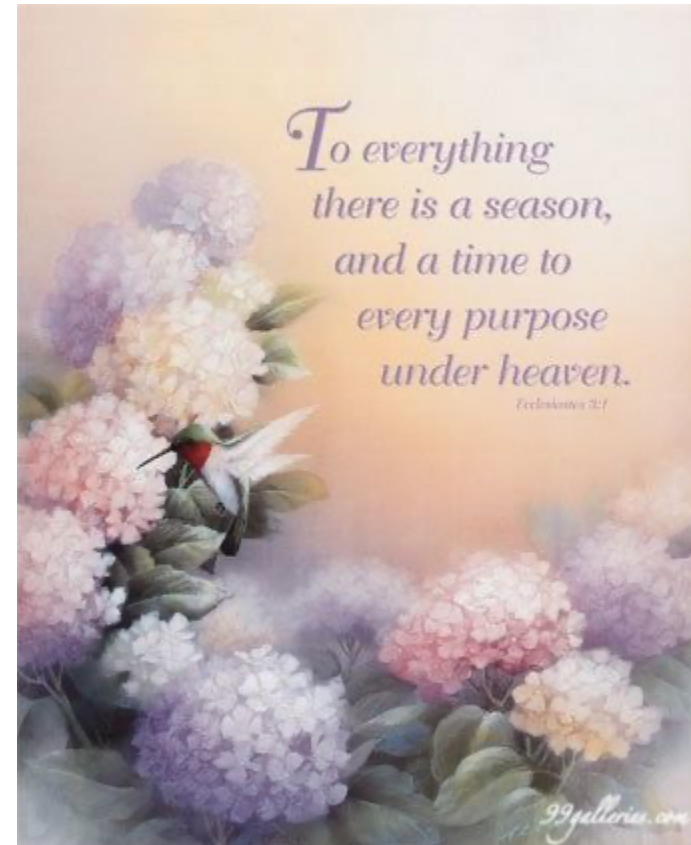
A time to rend, and a time to sew; a time to keep silence, and a time to speak;
