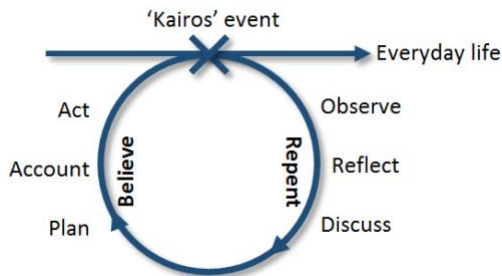


The Learning Circle – A Kairos Moment

Mark 1:15 “The *time* [kairos] has come. The kingdom of God has come near. *Repent* and *believe* the good news.”



The goal of the Learning Circle is to hear from God and put what God says into practice.



1. Identify a Kairos Moment from your past.

This might come to you by way of an event, a crisis, a Scripture, dream, conversation, film, song, or an inner prompting, or something else.

2. What did God say to you [repent]?

Repenting is not just feeling sorry about something, but instead is to stop, then observe, reflect, and then discuss what is happening with another person.

3. What did you or didn't you do about it [believe]?

Believing is about responding and acting on what God is prompting you to do. It includes committing to a plan, asking for accountability from a friend, and then acting in obedience. This is discipleship and produces growth and maturity.

Write here what you did [or did not] do in response to what God was prompting in this moment:

4. Share: share your Kairos Moment with a friend, or a mentor or mentee.

5. Identify one person whom you can teach/discuss The Learning Circle to/with this next week.
