If you are requesting OLC beyond 3 years, you must also provide a statement laying out the reasons for your request and how those reasons relate to the ministry and mission of the church.

A rostered person wishing to continue OLC status beyond 3 years, must make such a request in writing a minimum of 6 months before the completion of 3 years OLC status.
