We pledge to:

- Seek genuinely to discover what it means for Christ to be at the center of our relationship.
- Be open before God to evaluating our relationship and whether or not we should marry. At any time between now and the wedding date, if either of us feels that marriage is not right for us, we will postpone or cancel the wedding.
- Make every attempt to be on time and attend all sessions of the preparation-for-marriage meetings.

- Commit to not engaging in premarital sex. (If already involved: commit to abstain from further engagement in premarital sex and ask God for forgiveness.)
- Seek to plan a worshipful wedding ceremony that will honor God and reflect the sacredness of the vows that we make.
- Agree to abide by the wedding policies of the church.
- Seek to understand biblical principles for Christian marriage as it relates to our roles in marriage, submission and authority in marriage, and spiritual leadership in marriage.
- Seek to promote harmony among family members as we plan our wedding and as we live together in all the years of our marriage.
- Seek competent Christian marital counseling if we should encounter problems with which we cannot deal.
