THERE WILL BE A ONE BACKPACK POLICY. YOU'RE PACKING FOR TWO NIGHTS, NOT TWO WEEKS.

WHAT TO BRING:

- Bible

YOUTH EVANGELISM CELEBRATION GENERAL INFORMATION

- **WHAT EVEN IS YEC?**

YEC is a two day conference for youth aged students across the state. We will spend the bulk of our time at the Rapides Parish Coliseum in Alexandria, where we will have four sessions: one on Sunday night, and three on Monday. There will be a time of worship through song at each session, led by Crescent City Worship, NOBTS's traveling worship band, as well as a message from Shane Black, this year's speaker. There will also be a comedian, Jaron Myers, and Saturday night, Rend Collective will do a concert.

- **WHEN IS IT?**

It will be the first weekend of Thanksgiving break for your kids, Sunday November 23- Monday November 24.

- **WHEN WILL WE LEAVE?**

We will leave no later than 2:00 P.M. on Sunday November 24. This gives us time to drive to Alexandria and eat supper before going to the coliseum.

- **HOW WILL WE GET THERE?**

The chaperones will load students into their vehicles, and we will caravan all the way to Alexandria.

- **WHERE WILL WE STAY?**

In a hotel in Alexandria.

- **WHAT WILL WE EAT?**

On Sunday we will eat fast food before going to the coliseum. Monday we will eat breakfast in the hotel, and for lunch and supper on Monday we will eat fast food. There will be food trucks on sight at the coliseum for lunch on Monday (the food was pretty good last year), but if a chaperon wants to take some kids elsewhere, more power to them.

- **WHEN WILL WE COME BACK?**

Sometime between 11:00 P.M. 12 midnight on Monday, November 24. We likely won't stay for all of the concert. We don't want to drive that late, and y'all don't want to pick your kids up at 1:00 A.M... You're welcome. I accept cookies as tokens of appreciation ;)
