

**Instructions for the
EDWARD H. STAATS AND MARY STAATS
Memorial Scholarship**

The deadline for applications for the Staats Memorial Scholarship is **April 1, 2026**.

Please note: Graduating high school seniors will be given first preference regarding scholarships and amounts; however, university or technical school undergraduate students in good standing may also apply.

****Scholarship Requirements for Graduating High School Seniors****

To qualify for the scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a graduating high school senior in good standing who has demonstrated solid academic performance.
2. Be an active and faithful member of Saint Stephens Church.
3. Meet the admission requirements and be accepted by the school of their choice before the scholarship award is finalized.

****Application Process****

To apply for scholarship consideration, students must:

- Submit a completed typed application by April 1, 2026. This includes a typed list of activities as instructed on page 3 of the application.
- Complete the Scholarship Application Financial Information section and submit a copy of your FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid).
- Provide a typed personal statement detailing your goals and aspirations and explaining what Saint Stephens has meant to you in your life.
- Include a transcript of your high school credits and grades, along with a statement from your school confirming your grade point average (GPA) and class rank.
- Submit typewritten letters of recommendation from the following individuals:
 - Your high school principal
 - One high school teacher
 - One member of the community (who is not a relative)

****Requirements for University or Technical School Undergraduates****

- Must be a student in good standing at your institution, demonstrating strong academic performance.
- Must be an active and faithful member of Saint Stephen's Church, participating in its ministry.
- Submit a new, completed typed application by April 1, 2026. (Please provide typed activity information as instructed on page 3 of the application. Photocopies of previous applications will not be accepted.)
- Complete the financial information section of the scholarship application and include a copy of your FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid).
- Provide a typed personal statement detailing your continuing faith experiences beyond Saint Stephen's Church (as outlined on page 3 of the application).
- Include a transcript reflecting your undergraduate credits, grades, and overall academic standing.
- Submit a current typed letter of recommendation from a teacher, professor, or advisor at your current school.

- A **letter of recommendation** from your high school principal.
- A **letter of recommendation** from a high school teacher.
- A **letter of recommendation** from one member of the community (not a relative).

Undergraduates:

- A copy of your **FAFSA form**.
- A **typed Personal Statement**
- A **typed Activities** page
- A **transcript** reflecting your undergraduate credits, grades, and overall academic standing
- A **typed letter of recommendation** from a teacher, professor, or advisor at your school.
