To apply for scholarship consideration, the student must:

- Submit a completed, <u>typed</u> Application by April 15, 2024.
- Complete the Scholarship Application Financial Information portion and submit a copy of your FAFSA (see a high school counselor if you need help with this <u>requirement</u>).
- Submit your typed Faith Journey commentary.
- Submit a typed Narrative Personal Essay sharing your career goals, your faith journey, your plans for your future, and telling us why you are embarking on this particular choice for your future.
- Include a transcript of your high school credits and grades and a statement from your school containing your grade point average and class rank. (See your high school counselor.)
- Submit a typed letter of recommendation from an adult member of Saint Stephens (not a parent) who can attest to your faith journey and why you should be considered for this scholarship.
