Lent 5 MISSION MATTERS

We are approaching the climatic moment of accountability for the disciples' heart. We would all dearly love to convince ourselves that if we were at that time and place in history, we would definitely be follows and champions of Jesus' teaching and ministry. This scripture today was what motivated Mother Theresa to believe that she was actually serving Christ in the streets and orphanages of Calcutta. God cares deeply about how we treat our neighbours. This is not charity for charity's sake, or for making us feel righteous – this is the model of Christian discipleship that Jesus spoke of from the very beginning of his call to bring about the Kingdom of God. This text is not about handouts and good works, this is about changing the way we look at ourselves and our neighbours. This is about transformation and the resurrection of our communities, neighbourhoods, families, relationships and our hearts. In the almost and not yet of God's Kingdom, and God's promises, what we do matters.
