The salvation history of the Hebrew people continues with the Kings and wars and division. These stories were written down when the Hebrew people were in captivity the Babylonian Exile. They are remembering the faithfulness of their God to each other while sitting in desperate times. Pay close attention in this story to the cast of characters.

General Naaman is a powerful man in the army of King Aram, an enemy of the Israelites. As powerful as he is – he cannot escape the fact that he is afflicted with leprosy. Watch and listen to the ways that compassion becomes the good news of God's love in this narrative. In what ways does it matter to our daily lives and the experiences of others when we offer compassion as an expression of human connectedness, and in our own hearts, the very love of God? Let's experiment!
