I'm in God's Hands

Our second summer series at CCC is entitled "I'm in God's Hands" as we focus on a variety of Bible heroes, just like us, who faced huge trials, tribulations, disappointments and fears and yet found God takes care of it all. So far we have covered:

Gideon in Judges 6-8 as God calls him to lead the army into battle against 132,000+ with only 300 warriors and tells him to send the rest home!

Stephen in Acts 6-7 as he proclaims the Good News of Jesus Christ and calls the people to repent and put their faith in Jesus, leading the religious leaders to stone him. While being stoned, God reminds Stephen of where he is headed as heaven is opened up for him to see, giving him hope against the trial he was facing.

The Centurion in Luke 7 as his servant is deathly ill and puts his hope in Jesus to heal the servant, demonstrating amazing faith.

David in 1 Samuel 16-17 as he is anointed as king and fights the great giant Goliath, while still only a boy, yet with a huge faith and hope God can always deliver him.

Elijah in 1 Kings 18 as he faces the 450 prophets of Baal, trusting God to show Himself to the people, and finding God amazing everyone!
