

JANUARY DAILY PRAYER DEVOTIONALS

Please join Pastor Pat, the pastoral staff, and the elders each day for the month of January and pray for the following:

January 1: Prayer Connects Us to God's Heart

Scripture: Jeremiah 33:3

Devotional: God invites us to call on Him—not as a last resort, but as a first response. Prayer opens our hearts to His voice and His wisdom.

Pray: “Lord, help me hear You today.”

Prayer Focus: Spiritual Hunger

January 2: Prayer Changes Us Before It Changes Circumstances

Scripture: Psalm 51:10

Devotional: True prayer transforms our hearts. In prayer, we become more like Christ.

Pray: “Create in me a clean heart.”

Prayer Focus: Holiness in the Church

January 3: Prayer Releases God's Power

Scripture: James 5:16

Devotional: When God's people pray, spiritual power is released. Heaven engages. Chains break. Lives change.

Pray: “God, release Your power in my life.”

Prayer Focus: Fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit

January 4: Prayer Brings Peace in Chaos

Scripture: Philippians 4:6–7

Devotional: Anxiety dissolves in the presence of God. Prayer is a divine exchange—our fear for His peace.

Pray: “Lord, I give You my anxious thoughts.”

Prayer Focus: Trust in the Lord

January 5: Prayer Invites God Into Our Weakness

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 12:9

Devotional: Our weakness is not a barrier but an invitation for God's strength to shine.

Pray: “Be strong in my weakness today.”

Prayer Focus: Divine Strength

January 6: Prayer Strengthens Our Faith

Scripture: Mark 11:24

Devotional: Prayer is faith in action. Each time we pray, we declare that God hears and God responds.

Pray: “Increase my faith, Lord.”

Prayer Focus: Growing Faith

January 7: Prayer Aligns Us With God's Will

Scripture: Matthew 6:10

Devotional: Powerful prayer is not about convincing God to do our will—it's about aligning our hearts to His perfect plan.

Pray: “Your kingdom come, Your will be done.”

Prayer Focus: God's Will

January 8: Prayer Breaks Strongholds

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 10:4

Devotional: Some battles are spiritual, and prayer is the weapon that tears down every stronghold of the enemy.

Pray: “Break every stronghold over my life.”

Prayer Focus: The Addicted/Adult & Teen Challenge

January 9: Prayer Sustains Us Through Trials

Scripture: Psalm 46:1

Devotional: When life shakes, prayer steadies our soul. God is our refuge and strength.

Pray: “Lord, You are my refuge today.”

Prayer Focus: Endurance

January 10: Prayer Ushers in Revival

Scripture: 2 Chronicles 7:14

Devotional: Every move of God in history began with repentance and prayer. A repenting and praying church becomes a revived church.

Pray: "Revive us again, Lord."

Prayer: Revival in the Church

January 11: Prayer Draws Us Close to God

Scripture: James 4:8

Devotional: God promises to draw near when we draw near. Prayer closes the distance.

Pray: "Draw close to me, Father."

Prayer Focus: Upward Basketball

January 12: Prayer Renews Spiritual Strength

Scripture: Isaiah 40:31

Devotional: Prayer is how we wait upon the Lord and receive new strength for weary souls.

Pray: "Renew my strength today."

Prayer Focus: 180 Student Life Center

January 13: Prayer Helps Us Overcome Temptation

Scripture: Matthew 26:41

Devotional: In prayer, we receive divine strength to resist what the enemy brings against us.

Pray: "Keep me from temptation."

Prayer Focus: The Youth and Young Adults

January 14: Prayer Opens Closed Doors

Scripture: Revelation 3:7–8

Devotional: God opens doors no man can shut. Prayer positions us for divine opportunities.

Pray: "Lord Jesus, open the doors You want me to walk through."

Prayer Focus: Soul Winning/Lost Souls

January 15: Prayer Invites God's Provision

Scripture: Matthew 6:11

Devotional: God delights in meeting the needs of His children when they come to Him with childlike faith.

Pray: "Lord, thank you for being my daily Provider."

Prayer Focus: Greece Christian School – Pre-K through 8th Grade

January 16: Prayer Brings Healing

Scripture: Psalm 103:3

Devotional: God heals bodies, minds, and hearts. Prayer invites His healing touch.

Pray: "Lord, I humbly ask that You heal what is broken in me."

Prayer Focus: Children's Ministry

January 17: Prayer Protects Us From the Enemy

Scripture: Psalm 91:1

Devotional: Prayer places us under the shadow of the Almighty—our refuge and fortress.

Pray: "Lord, protect me from the enemy of my soul."

Prayer Focus: Senior Saints

January 18: Prayer Builds Spiritual Sensitivity

Scripture: John 10:27

Devotional: As we pray, we learn to recognize His voice more clearly.

Pray: "Lord, help me hear Your voice."

Prayer Focus: Husbands/Wives/Marriages

January 19: Prayer Ushers in Wisdom

Scripture: James 1:5

Devotional: God gives wisdom generously to those who ask. Prayer unlocks divine guidance.

Pray: "Lord, grant me wisdom today."

Prayer Focus: Single Adults/Widows/Widowers

January 20: Prayer Deepens Our Love for Others

Scripture: Ephesians 3:17–19

Devotional: Praying for others expands our capacity to love them with Christlike love.

Pray: “Lord, help me love like You love.”

Prayer Focus: Mission Share

January 21: Prayer Makes the Impossible Possible

Scripture: Luke 1:37

Devotional: Nothing is beyond God’s reach. Prayer brings the supernatural into the natural.

Pray: “Lord, please work the impossible in my life.”

Prayer Focus: Missions/Missionaries

January 22: Prayer Invites God’s Presence

Scripture: Psalm 16:11

Devotional: In prayer, we walk into the fullness of joy found in God’s presence.

Pray: “Lord, thank You for Your presence in my life.”

Prayer Focus: Elders

January 23: Prayer Brings Breakthrough

Scripture: Acts 12:5–7

Devotional: When the church prayed, chains fell off Peter. Prayer breaks chains today.

Pray: “Lord, please provide a breakthrough in my situation.”

Prayer Focus: Deacons

January 24: Prayer Drives Out Fear

Scripture: Isaiah 41:10

Devotional: Fear cannot remain where God’s presence dwells. Prayer fills us with His courage.

Pray: “Silence my fears.”

Prayer Focus: Pastoral Team

January 25: Prayer Builds Unity

Scripture: Acts 1:14

Devotional: The early church prayed together—and God made them one. Prayer unites hearts.

Pray: “Lord, strengthen and unite our hearts in prayer.”

Prayer Focus: Unity

January 26: Prayer Releases God’s Favor

Scripture: Psalm 5:12

Devotional: Favor follows those who walk close to God in prayer and obedience.

Pray: “Lord, may Your favor surround me.”

Prayer Focus: God’s Favor in the Community

January 27: Prayer Strengthens Our Hope

Scripture: Romans 15:13

Devotional: Prayer fills us with hope that overflows by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Pray: “Lord, thank You for filling me with hope.”

January 28: Prayer Helps Us Walk in Purpose

Scripture: Psalm 32:8

Devotional: God leads us step by step when we seek Him in prayer.

Pray: “Lord, please guide my steps today.”

Prayer Focus: Greece Town Government

January 29: Prayer Prepares Us for spiritual battles

Scripture: Ephesians 6:18

Devotional: Prayer is not optional armor—it is essential for victory.

Pray: “Lord, strengthen me for the battle.”

Prayer Focus: First Responders – Police/Fire/EMT

Scripture: Exodus 33:18

Devotional: Like Moses, we can pray, "Show me Your glory"—and God reveals Himself to hungry hearts.

Scripture: Exodus 33:11

Devotional: God desires more than servants—He desires friends. Prayer builds that friendship.

Pray: "Lord, draw me into deeper friendship with You."

The National Day of Prayer Greece Assembly of God Thursday, May 7, 2026 - 7:00 PM

Join us as our community gathers with one heart and one voice on the National Day of Prayer. On this sacred day, believers from several gospel preaching congregations, across our county will come together to call on the LORD.

More than ever, our county, our state, and our nation need God's wisdom, mercy, grace, and healing. We are living in a time marked by division, confusion, and spiritual hunger. The Scripture reminds us that "*Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord*" (Psalm 33:12), and that when God's people humble themselves, repent, and pray, He hears from heaven and responds with power (2 Chronicles 7:14). This is why the National Day of Prayer matters so deeply—and why our participation is so vital.

The county-wide prayer service will bring together pastors, leaders, families, and believers from around the greater Rochester area. We will lift up heartfelt prayer for our communities, our leaders, our schools, our churches, and especially the next generation. Together, we will stand as a unified body of Christ, declaring our dependence on God and inviting His presence to move among us.

This service will be a time of worship, Scripture reading, and focused intercession—an evening set apart to call on the name of the Lord with one voice. I cannot think of a more important gathering for us to attend. There will be a special youth and young adult choir that will be sure to draw us into the presence of God.

I encourage you to make this service a priority. Bring your family, invite your friends, and let's link arms with our brothers and sisters across the county as we seek God for a fresh move of His Spirit.
