

Small Group Discussion Questions

- 1) If you, like the scribe in this story, could ask Jesus one question today, what would it be?
- 2) Read today's passage (**Mark 12:28-34**), review the sermon points, and share anything from the sermon that you found especially interesting, challenging or useful.
- 3) In your own words, why are the commands to **"love the Lord"** and to **"love your neighbor"**, inseparable? How does it harm our witness to the world when we get out of balance in either direction?
- 4) Think of where you spend the majority of your time each day (work, school, home, etc.). In practical terms, what could/should **"loving the Lord with all your heart, soul, mind & strength"** in that place look like?
- 5) What are some things our church family can do to love our neighbors right here in the Taylor neighborhood, since not many of them currently attend our Sunday services? What could your part be?
- 6) Jesus' final words to the scribe in **v.34** were both a compliment and a warning. What was still missing in this man's life, and who do you know that might be in the same spiritual place as he was?
