1. What is the most impressive building, monument or natural wonder (mountain, ocean, etc.) you've ever seen in person?
2. Read today's passage (**Mark 13:1-23**), review the sermon points, and share anything from the sermon that you found especially interesting, challenging or useful.
3. What is your primary attitude toward end-times prophecy — excitement, confusion, fear or something else — and did this week's sermon help you with that in any way?
4. Review the things which must happen before “the end” in **vv.9-20**. How can we explain the fact that so many will still end up rejecting Christ despite the fact that He so clearly declared how events are going to unfold? How might this impact the ways in which we share our faith with unbelievers?
5. Now go back through the list of things we must all “**be ready for**” as Christians. Share with the group the one(s) in which you would most like to grow.
6. Briefly review the main part of Jesus' teaching in **vv.5-23**. Amidst what can be seen as a difficult and *discouraging* passage, which words of hope that Jesus spoke *encourage* you most?
