

## Small Group Study Questions

1. Have you ever had to testify in court? If so, what was it like?
2. Read today's passage (**Mark 14:53-65**), review the sermon points, and share anything from the sermon that you found especially interesting, challenging or useful.
3. As high priest, no one in Israel should've been more ready and willing to accept Jesus as the Messiah than Caiaphas; yet here we see him leading the opposition to Him (**vv.55-61**). Why do you believe Caiaphas found it impossible to follow Jesus, and is there anything we can learn from that today?
4. Part of Jesus' answer in **v.62** makes it clear that He will be everyone's final judge. Why is it important to include the fact of God's judgment when we share the gospel with unbelievers, and what do they need to know about it?
5. The rest of Jesus' words in **v.62** announce His glorious Second Coming. Why is Christ's return something that we can and should look forward to? What about it gives you, personally, the greatest joy?
