As we mentioned in our last letter, Mary Lu and Javier Orlando led a Kairos course over five Saturdays in our local church in San Pedro Sula, from January 12 to February 9. It was our first time doing a course in this format, but it could not have gone better. There were 15 people in the course. Some were youth who had done The Unfinished Story in youth camp last December and wanted to know more. Three were from three other churches. Mary Lu and Javier Orlando did an excellent job, alternating Saturdays as Head Facilitator.

Our aim is to see a mobilization movement that can sustain a mission sending movement. To see that, we have to involve as many churches as possible.

Please pray for this time in Peru. For the courses and the contacts we will make. Pray that God will speak to each participant in the courses. And for the finances for the trip. We invested in this trip without any specific giving towards it because we believe it is what God is calling us
