It has been difficult to reach due to the fact that it is much more rural and jobs are difficult to find (the majority of staff that are

part of our movement are volunteers, working full time professionally). ECU has asked us to plant ministry and start new student groups on the universities in this region.

We are really excited for this opportunity. The southern zone is much more rural and life will be quite a bit different than in the big busy capital city of San Jose. With the mountains, pineapple farms and year round greenness it is not lowa but for Costa Rica it's about as close as it gets:) Also, we have had many experiences with planting new student groups with InterVarsity Christian Fellowship in the United States and love the call of starting something new.

In June one of our dreams in coming to Costa Rica came true as we hosted our first student team from InterVarsity. Part of our time included heading to what will be our new home while doing outreach and service on campus. It was such a

gift to have this team with us! We had been praying for God to go ahead of us and prepare the way. We were overwhelmed by His faithfulness. We met over 150 students add received contact information of over 50 students that expressed a desire to join us in starting ECU on their campus!
