Purpose

Deacons of Care are servants in the church who help care for the practical and care needs of those at Moran Park (financial, emotional, relational, grief, prayer, etc).

Qualifications

- Has attended Moran Park for at least one year.

Acts 6:1-7

- Full of the Spirit - Bears the fruit of the Spirit in their life not the fruit of the sinful nature.
- Wisdom – Knowing what step God wants them to take and then taking it. Love for God’s word and walking in his ways (James 3:13-18). Walks according to God’s wisdom not the wisdom of the world (1 Cor 3:18-19).

1 Timothy 3:8-13

- Worthy of respect – honorable, good character.
- Sincere – not a hypocrite, honest, authentic.
- Doesn’t abuse alcohol or drugs
- Not pursuing dishonest gain – Not greedy for money, position, or power.
- Hold to deep truths of the faith with a clear conscience. Hold to doctrine and Biblical soundness.
- Tested – examine, scrutinize. Are they who they say they are? Have you watched them in action? Does anyone else have anything against them?
- Be dignified – worthy of respect.
- Don’t gossip, slander, lie.
- Self controlled, temperate, not prone to emotionalism.
- Faithful in all things – trustworthy.
- Don’t cheat on spouse - sexually pure.
- Manage household well

- Desire for people to grow as disciples of Jesus.
- Discerning and able to keep confidences.
