May the Lord steady your heart today and fill you with the hope that only Christ can give.

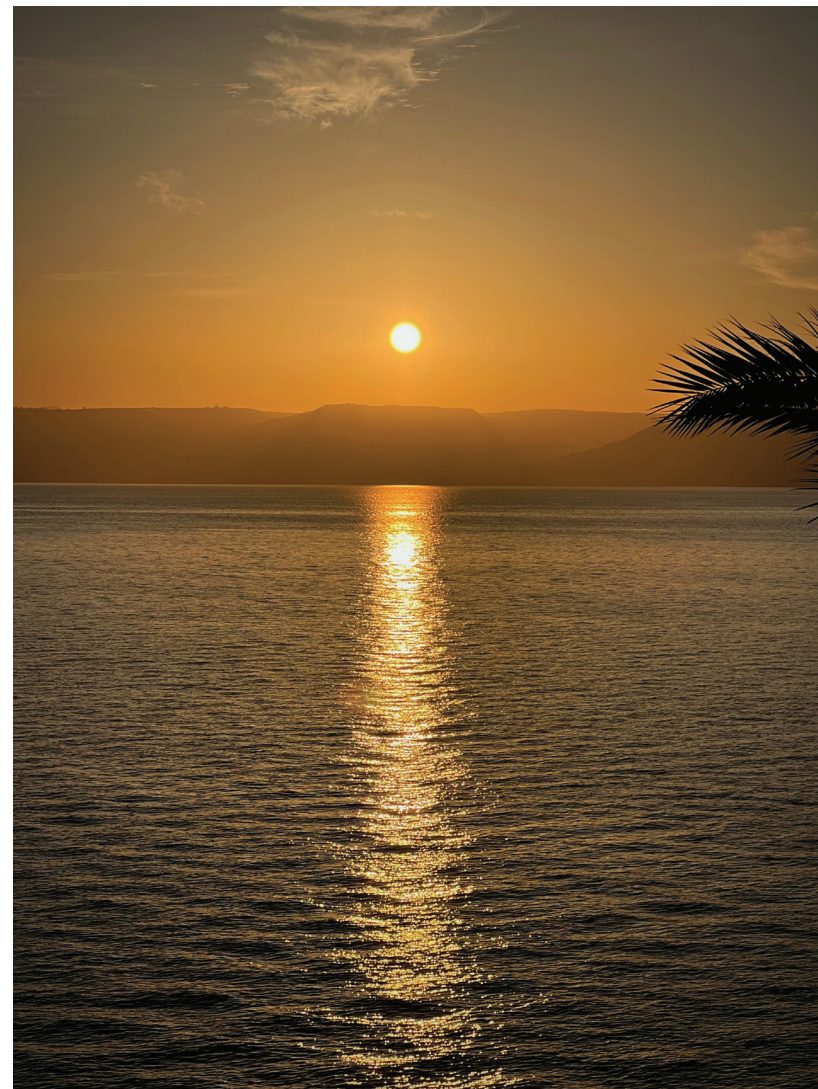
