About the Event:

Mega 5 Camp is a fun-filled experience that features activities within five disciplines: Sports, Performing Arts, Culinary Arts, Visual Arts, and Outdoor Skills. Anyone who has children knows that they love to learn new things together! Mega 5 Camp gives the chance to do just that. They can try something new or develop an already skill.

Mega 5 Camp Preschoolers will be hosting "Amazing Athletes," who will focus on teaching children life skills through 10 different sports. Preschoolers will be using their motor skills, learning nutrition and muscle identification, while being introduced to Football, Hockey, Lacrosse, Golf, Baseball, Basketball, Tennis, Volleyball, Track & Field, and Soccer.

What kids will learn:

Children will select **one activity** to participate in for the **entire week**, based on his/her interests. They will not be allowed to change the activity throughout the week, so make sure you choose wisely! Kids will learn about the specific activity for roughly one hour a day. They will also have a devotional and small snack. We are excited that children will be able to excel in an area of passion and interest and connect with God and other friends in the process.

Preschoolers will learn 2 sports each night, participate in an exciting large group with Bible story and Praise & Worship. Classroom time will have engaging activities to reinforce the Bible story, Bible Verse and snack.

Registration Dates: Online registration closes on **June 9**. Walk-ins are welcome. Classes have a limited number of people and will fill up on a first-come, first-serve basis. Flexibility is appreciated!

Drop Off/Pick Up: The safety of all children is of utmost importance. All children will be dropped off and picked up in the Worship Center. Since we have a large group and a large campus, we need to lock down the campus by 6:15pm each day. We ask every child be on time so that we can make this possible. If you have something scheduled and know you will be late, please let us know so that we can make plans to get your child in place after that time. Only volunteers who have been background checked are allowed on our campus after Opening Session ends.

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For pick up we use security tags. Guardians will be provided with these in advance. The children and guardian will have a matching tag that we will match at pick up. If for some reason you do not have your tag, you will need your driver's license for pick up. Online people listed as approved people to pick up will be allowed to pick up the children.

Preschool Drop off / Pickup: The safety of children is of the utmost importance to us. Preschool children will be dropped off by their parents directly to their classrooms and after any older siblings have been dropped off in the Worship Center. Room assignments will be listed on each child's name tag that are included in your packet. If you have an older sibling, they will need to be picked up in the Worship Center prior to picking up your preschooler.

Frequently Asked Questions:

- **What if I sign up for one class and then change my mind?**
 - We are excited about all of the classes we are offering. Please carefully select online. Once children register, they will not be able to change their class selection.
- **Can I switch classes in the middle of the week?**
 - Children will need to stay in the same class all four days. The size of our group makes switching children around a safety issue. In addition, many of the projects and activities build upon what is learned the previous day, or are on-going projects.
- **What if I bring a friend and my class is full?**
 - We hope everyone will bring friends and we want everyone to have a positive experience!!! If you are planning on bringing a friend, the best thing to do is to pre-register both children together! But we know that is not always possible. Some friends may have different interests and want to be in different classes. We are excited about the variety and quality of all of the classes we are offering! You can look any time online to see which classes have available spots.
- **What if I have allergies?**
 - We provide our teachers with a list of all students who have reported allergy issues. Allergies are also listed on the security name tags. We will provide a snack menu and an allergy alternative each day. If your child has food allergies, please send in a suitable snack for your child and make sure to discuss with your child's teacher at drop off.
 - Monday: Individual goldfish pack
 - Tuesday: individual Lay's classic potato chips
 - Wednesday: individual cheez-it packs
 - Thursday: Individual oreos
- **Are walk-in registrations allowed?**
