REVIEW

1. Read Ephesians 2:11-13. What language and terms did Paul use to describe the situation of Gentiles before coming to know Christ?
2. All who trust in the Lord Jesus Christ are brought into the family of the Redeemed. What has God done to demolish the barriers between Gentiles and Jews?

ASSESS

3. How have you seen, or experienced, gospel-centered reconciliation between people?
4. Are there aspects of your background (nationality, ethnicity, social class, education, etc.) that have become a barrier (perhaps even subconsciously) to you forming strong relationships with other Christians?

5. How does it affect you to "remember" your situation before you knew Christ? How are you encouraged by meditating on your new status in Christ?

APPLY

6. Is there another Christian who has offended you and hurt you deeply? How does looking at what Jesus did on the cross empower you to forgive them?
7. Read 2 Corinthians 5:17. What is a practical way for me to live out the significance of this study in relational conflict (marriage, family, church, and even in political views)?

PRAYER

There is no greater love than what God has displayed in Christ for us! In your closing time together, include prayers of thankfulness for the stories God has worked and allowed you to hear and share. Ask Him to keep working in you and to allow you to see those around you who are longing to hear God's story of grace for the first time.
