### **CREATING A FAMILY MISSION STATEMENT:**

# Here are some Bible passages that speak to having a Kingdom Mission:

## Psalm 127:1

Unless the LORD builds the house, the builders labor in vain.

#### Matthew 28:19-20

Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

#### Colossians 1:28-29

So we tell others about Christ, warning everyone and teaching everyone with all the wisdom God has given us. We want to present them to God, perfect in their relationship to Christ. That's why I work and struggle so hard, depending on Christ's mighty power that works within me.

## **QUESTIONS FOR MOM & DAD:**

- What do we want to be the foundation of our home?
- What kind of parents do we want to be?
- What principles and character traits do we want to teach our children?
- What sort of people do we want our kids to be when they are adults?

# **QUESTIONS FOR KIDS:**

- What kind of feeling do we want to have in our home?
- What kind of home would you like to invite your friends to?
- How should we treat each other in our family?
- Who are our heroes (not just super heroes)? What it is about them we want to be like?

# Capture key themes and ideas:

During the discussion, some common themes and words will start to emerge. Make sure you write them down.

These words and phrases will help you discover your family values, which is what we'll be refining in the next step.

Each family is unique, so it's important to identify things that are truly important to your family. It's fine for values to be big, but if they are too removed from how you actually live your lives, they won't work. So don't choose things that you think 'should' be included, choose the ones that truly resonate and inspire each member of your family.

These are the values that can help guide your family for many years to come.

"Values are not end goals, they are guidelines for our actions."
