*<sup>6</sup> On what were its footings set,  
or who laid its cornerstone...*

**READ: Romans 6:9-10**

*<sup>9</sup> For we know that since Christ was raised from the dead, he cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over him. <sup>10</sup> The death he died, he died to sin once for all; but the life he lives, he lives to God.*

**READ: 1 John 4:14-15**

*<sup>14</sup> And we have seen and testify that the Father has sent his Son to be the Savior of the world. <sup>15</sup> If anyone acknowledges that Jesus is the Son of God, God lives in them and they in God.*

 **Middle Knowledge**

**READ: 1 Peter 1:1-2**

*To God's elect, exiles scattered throughout the provinces of Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia and Bithynia, <sup>2</sup> who have been chosen according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through the sanctifying work of the Spirit, to be obedient to Jesus Christ and sprinkled with his blood.*

## Evangelism and the Sovereignty of God

### READ: Romans 10:12-15

<sup>12</sup> For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile—the same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses all who call on him, <sup>13</sup> for, “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”

<sup>14</sup> How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? <sup>15</sup> And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: “How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!”

**READ: DD-60**

**READ: 1 John 2:17**

<sup>17</sup> The world and its desires pass away, but whoever does the will of God lives forever.

**Think Deeper:** According to this verse who lives forever?



5 POINTS OF CALVANISM:

- **T - Total Depravity (or Total Inability):** As a result of the Fall, every person is enslaved to sin and entirely incapable of saving themselves or choosing to follow God on their own.
- **U - Unconditional Election:**  
  
Before the world's foundation, God chose (elected) specific individuals for salvation based solely on His own sovereign will, not based on any merit or foreseen faith in the person.
- **L - Limited Atonement (or Particular Redemption):** Jesus Christ's death on the cross was intended to pay the penalty only for the sins of the elect (those chosen by God), making the atonement successful rather than merely potential.
- **I - Irresistible Grace:** When God calls the elect to salvation, they cannot refuse. The Holy Spirit acts in a way that overcomes human resistance, leading them to repentance and faith.
- **P - Perseverance of the Saints:** Those whom God has chosen and called will be preserved in faith by His power. They cannot lose their salvation and will endure to the end.
