READ: Hebrews 11:3

“By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God’s command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible.”

READ: Proverbs 8:22-36

²³ I was formed long ages ago,

at the very beginning, when the world came to be.

²⁴ When there were no watery depths, I was given birth,
when there were no springs overflowing with water;

²⁵ before the mountains were settled in place,
before the hills, I was given birth,

²⁶ before he made the world or its fields
or any of the dust of the earth.

²⁷ I was there when he set the heavens in place,
when he marked out the horizon on the face of the deep,

 **Creation Days**

READ: Genesis 1:1-5

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. ² Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters. And God said, “Let there be light,” and there was light. ⁴ God saw that the light was good, and he separated the light from the darkness. ⁵ God called the light “day,” and the darkness he called “night.” And there was evening, and there was morning—the first day.

THINK ABOUT IT: What was created first?

READ: DD-63

READ: Genesis 1:14-19

¹⁴ And God said, “Let there be lights in the vault of the sky to separate the day from the night, and let them serve as signs to mark sacred times, and days and years, ¹⁵ and let them be lights in the vault of the sky to give light on the earth.” And it was so. ¹⁶ God made two great lights—the greater light to govern the day and the lesser light to govern the night. He also made the stars. ¹⁷ God set them in the vault of the sky to give light on the earth, ¹⁸ to govern the day and the night, and to separate light from darkness. And God saw that it was good. ¹⁹ And there was evening, and there was morning—the fourth day.

Think Deeper: What was created on day four? How was it different from day one?

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 1 [DAY 64]

 **Historical Adam**

READ: Genesis 2:7

⁷ Then the LORD God formed a man^w from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living being.

THINK ABOUT IT: What does this tell you about Adam?

READ: DD-64

READ: 1 Corinthians 15:44-49

If there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual body. ⁴⁵ So it is written: “The first man Adam became a living being”; the last Adam, a life-giving spirit. ⁴⁶ The spiritual did not come first, but the natural, and after that the spiritual. ⁴⁷ The first man was of the dust of the earth; the second man is of heaven. ⁴⁸ As was the earthly man, so are those who are of the earth; and as is the heavenly man, so also are those who are of heaven. ⁴⁹ And just as we have borne the image of the earthly man, so shall we bear the image of the heavenly man.

Think Deeper: How does this passage talk about Adam? What does it mean for us?

READ: Psalm 33:8-9

⁸ *Let all the earth fear the LORD;
let all the people of the world revere him.*
⁹ *For he spoke, and it came to be;
he commanded, and it stood firm.*

THINK ABOUT IT: When you think about creation what do you feel?

READ: DD-65

READ: Psalm 148:5-6

*Let them praise the name of the LORD,
for at his command they were created,
⁶ and he established them for ever and ever—
he issued a decree that will never pass away.*

Think Deeper: What do you think about the statement, “Creation was God’s decision to go public.”
