Demons

READ: Matthew 12:22-24

²² Then they brought him a demon-possessed man who was blind and mute, and Jesus healed him, so that he could both talk and see. ²³ All the people were astonished and said, “Could this be the Son of David?”

²⁴ But when the Pharisees heard this, they said, “It is only by Beelzebul, the prince of demons, that this fellow drives out demons.

THINK ABOUT IT: What do these verses tell you about demons?

READ: James 2:19

You believe that there is one God. Good! Even the demons believe that—and shudder.

READ: Ephesians 6:12

¹² For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.

Providence

READ: Psalm 33:10-11

*¹⁰ The LORD foils the plans of the nations;
he thwarts the purposes of the peoples.
¹¹ But the plans of the LORD stand firm forever,
the purposes of his heart through all generations.*

THINK ABOUT IT: What exactly is providence?

READ: DD-68

READ: Isaiah 46:9-10

⁹ Remember the former things, those of long ago;
I am God, and there is no other;
I am God, and there is none like me.
¹⁰ I make known the end from the beginning,
from ancient times, what is still to come.
I say, 'My purpose will stand,
and I will do all that I please.'

READ: Psalm 77:14

*¹⁴ You are the God who performs miracles;
you display your power among the peoples.*

*⁴ Jesus said to them, "A prophet is not without honor
except in his own town, among his relatives and in his
own home."⁵ He could not do any miracles there, except
lay his hands on a few sick people and heal them. ⁶ He
was amazed at their lack of faith.*

READ: Acts 2:22

*²² "Fellow Israelites, listen to this: Jesus of Nazareth was a man
accredited by God to you by miracles, wonders and signs, which
God did among you through him, as you yourselves know*

Prayer

READ: Deuteronomy 4:7

⁷ What other nation is so great as to have their gods near them the way the LORD our God is near us whenever we pray to him?

THINK ABOUT IT: What is prayer for?

READ: DD- 70

READ: Matthew 11:24-16

²⁴ Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.

²⁵ And when you stand praying, if you hold anything against anyone, forgive them, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you your sins."

READ: Matthew :7-8

⁷ And when you pray, do not keep on babbling like pagans, for they think they will be heard because of their many words. ⁸ Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him.

Think Deeper: How does prayer work?
