Sins Made More Heinous

READ: 1 John 5:16-17

*¹⁶ If you see any brother or sister commit a sin that does not
lead to death, you should pray and God will give them life. I
refer to those whose sin does not lead to death. There is a sin
that leads to death. I am not saying that you should pray about
that. ¹⁷ All wrongdoing is sin, and there is sin that does not lead
to death.*

THINK ABOUT IT: What do you think is the sin that leads to
death ? And which sin does not lead to death?

READ: DD- 87

READ: Mark 3:28-29 (Luke 12:10)

*²⁸ Truly I tell you, people can be forgiven all their sins and every
slander they utter, ²⁹ but whoever blasphemes against the Holy
Spirit will never be forgiven; they are guilty of an eternal sin."*

Think Deeper: Do you believe there is a ranking of sins?
If so, which sins are worse?

Concupiscence

READ: Ezekiel 18:20

The one who sins is the one who will die. The child will not share the guilt of the parent, nor will the parent share the guilt of the child. The righteousness of the righteous will be credited to them, and the wickedness of the wicked will be charged against them.

THINK ABOUT IT: What does this verse tell us about the nature of sin?

READ: DD- 88

READ: Ezekiel 18:30

“Therefore, you Israelites, I will judge each of you according to your own ways, declares the Sovereign LORD. Repent! Turn away from all your offenses; then sin will not be your downfall. ³¹Rid yourselves of all the offenses you have committed, and get a new heart and a new spirit. Why will you die, people of Israel? ³²For I take no pleasure in the death of anyone, declares the Sovereign LORD. Repent and live!

Think Deeper: What do these verses tell you about sin and God’s attitude towards it?

Temptation

READ: James 1:13-15

¹³When tempted, no one should say, “God is tempting me.” For God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does he tempt anyone; ¹⁴but each person is tempted when they are dragged away by their own evil desire and enticed. ¹⁵Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death.

THINK ABOUT IT: Where does temptation begin?

READ: DD- 89

READ: Hebrews 4:14-16

¹⁴Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has ascended into heaven, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess. ¹⁵For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet he did not sin. ¹⁶Let us then approach God’s throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

Think Deeper: What do these verses tell you about temptation? Where does it come from?

What Difference Does the Doctrine of Sin Make?

READ: Romans 7:14-20

¹⁴ We know that the law is spiritual; but I am unspiritual, sold as a slave to sin.
¹⁵ I do not understand what I do. For what I want to do I do not do, but what I hate I do. ¹⁶ And if I do what I do not want to do, I agree that the law is good.
¹⁷ As it is, it is no longer I myself who do it, but it is sin living in me. ¹⁸ For I know that good itself does not dwell in me, that is, in my sinful nature. For I have the desire to do what is good, but I cannot carry it out. ¹⁹ For I do not do the good I want to do, but the evil I do not want to do—this I keep on doing.
²⁰ Now if I do what I do not want to do, it is no longer I who do it, but it is sin living in me that does it.

THINK ABOUT IT: What is our relationship with sin?

READ: DD- 90

READ: Romans 7:21-25

²¹ So I find this law at work: Although I want to do good, evil is right there with me. ²² For in my inner being I delight in God's law; ²³ but I see another law at work in me, waging war against the law of my mind and making me a prisoner of the law of sin at work within me. ²⁴ What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body that is subject to death? ²⁵ Thanks be to God, who delivers me through Jesus Christ our Lord!
