But in the account of the burning bush, even Moses showed that the dead rise, for he calls the Lord ‘the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.’³⁸ He is not the God of the dead, but of the living, for to him all are alive.”

Davidic Covenant

READ: 2 Samuel 7:11-16

“The LORD declares to you that the LORD himself will establish a house for you: ¹² When your days are over and you rest with your ancestors, I will raise up your offspring to succeed you, your own flesh and blood, and I will establish his kingdom. ¹³ He is the one who will build a house for my Name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever. ¹⁴ I will be his father, and he will be my son. When he does wrong, I will punish him with a rod wielded by men, with floggings inflicted by human hands. ¹⁵ But my love will never be taken away from him, as I took it away from Saul, whom I removed from before you. ¹⁶ Your house and your kingdom will endure forever before me; your throne will be established forever.’

THINK ABOUT IT: Why did God establish a covenant with David?

READ: Mark 12:35-37

³⁵ While Jesus was teaching in the temple courts, he asked, “Why do the teachers of the law say that the Messiah is the son of David?³⁶ David himself, speaking by the Holy Spirit, declared:

“The Lord said to my Lord: “Sit at my right hand until I put your enemies under your feet.”

³⁷ David himself calls him ‘Lord.’ How then can he be his son?”

Think Deeper: How would you answer Jesus’ question?

New Covenant

READ: Jeremiah 31:31-32

³¹ *“The days are coming,” declares the LORD,
“when I will make a new covenant
with the people of Israel
and with the people of Judah.
³² It will not be like the covenant
I made with their ancestors
when I took them by the hand
to lead them out of Egypt,
because they broke my covenant,
though I was a husband to them,”
declares the LORD.*

THINK ABOUT IT: What is the purpose of the New Covenant?

⁷ *For if there had been nothing wrong with that first covenant, no place would have been sought for another.* ⁸ *But God found fault with the people and said:*

*“The days are coming, declares the Lord,
when I will make a new covenant
with the people of Israel
and with the people of Judah.*

The Fathers Have Eaten Sour Grapes

READ: Jeremiah 31:27-30

²⁷ *“The days are coming,” declares the LORD, “when I will plant the kingdoms of Israel and Judah with the offspring of people and of animals. ²⁸ Just as I watched over them to uproot and tear down, and to overthrow, destroy and bring disaster, so I will watch over them to build and to plant,” declares the LORD. ²⁹ “In those days people will no longer say,*

*‘The parents have eaten sour grapes,
and the children’s teeth are set on edge.’*

³⁰ *Instead, everyone will die for their own sin; whoever eats sour grapes—their own teeth will be set on edge.*

THINK ABOUT IT: What’s the point of the sour grapes?

READ: DD- 104

READ: Acts 3:25-26

²⁵ *And you are heirs of the prophets and of the covenant God made with your fathers. He said to Abraham, ‘Through your offspring all peoples on earth will be blessed.’ ²⁶ When God raised up his servant, he sent him first to you to bless you by turning each of you from your wicked ways.”*

Think Deeper: How was the Old Covenant both Corporate and individual and how is the new both individual and corporate?

The Newness of the New Covenant

READ: Romans 3:21-24

²¹ But now apart from the law the righteousness of God has been made known, to which the Law and the Prophets testify. ²² This righteousness is given through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. There is no difference between Jew and Gentile, ²³ for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, ²⁴ and all are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus.

THINK ABOUT IT: If there is a way to be righteous apart from the law, why did we need the law?

READ: DD- 105

READ: Hebrews 8:6-7

⁶ But in fact the ministry Jesus has received is as superior to theirs as the covenant of which he is mediator is superior to the old one, since the new covenant is established on better promises.

⁷ For if there had been nothing wrong with that first covenant, no place would have been sought for another.

Think Deeper: What are the better promises of the New Covenant?
