Hypostatic Union

READ: Philippians 2:5-8

⁵In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: ⁶Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; ⁷rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.

⁸And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death—even death on a cross!

THINK ABOUT IT: How do you see hypostasis at work in these verses?

READ: DD- 121

READ: 1 John 4:2-3

²This is how you can recognize the Spirit of God: Every spirit that acknowledges that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God, ³but every spirit that does not acknowledge Jesus is not from God. This is the spirit of the antichrist, which you have heard is coming and even now is already in the world.

THINK DEEPER: Why is the fact that Jesus came in the flesh so vital to our faith?

Communicatio Idiomatum

READ: John 17:20-21

²⁰“My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, ²¹that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me.

THINK ABOUT IT: How would you describe the difference between nature and property?

READ: DD- 122

READ: John 17:22-23

²²I have given them the glory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one—²³I in them and you in me—so that they may be brought to complete unity. Then the world will know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me.

THINK DEEPER: What does it mean that. What Christ did, he did as a single person, the union of two natures? And what does that mean for us when we accept Christ?

How Do The Two Natures Relate to Each Other?

READ: John 10:34-38

³⁴ Jesus answered them, "Is it not written in your Law, 'I have said you are "gods" '? ³⁵ If he called them 'gods,' to whom the word of God came—and Scripture cannot be set aside—³⁶ what about the one whom the Father set apart as his very own and sent into the world? Why then do you accuse me of blasphemy because I said, 'I am God's Son'? ³⁷ Do not believe me unless I do the works of my Father. ³⁸ But if I do them, even though you do not believe me, believe the works, that you may know and understand that the Father is in me, and I in the Father.

THINK ABOUT IT: How can deity and humanity co-exist?

READ: DD- 123

READ: John 5:19-20

¹⁹ Jesus gave them this answer: "Very truly I tell you, the Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees his Father doing, because whatever the Father does the Son also does. ²⁰ For the Father loves the Son and shows him all he does. Yes, and he will show him even greater works than these, so that you will be amazed.

THINK DEEPER: How does the Father show the Son all He does?

The Extra Calvinisticum

READ: Colossians 2:9-10

⁹ For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form, ¹⁰ and in Christ you have been brought to fullness. He is the head over every power and authority.

READ: DD- 124

READ: Philippians 2:9-11

⁹ Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, ¹⁰ that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹ and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

THINK DEEPER: Do you think Jesus divinity and humanity remained "indissolubly joined" after Jesus ascension?

Christological Heresies

READ: 2 John 7-8

⁷ I say this because many deceivers, who do not acknowledge Jesus Christ as coming in the flesh, have gone out into the world. Any such person is the deceiver and the antichrist.

⁸ Watch out that you do not lose what we have worked for, but that you may be rewarded fully.

THINK ABOUT IT: What makes something a heresy?

READ: DD- 125

READ: 2 Peter 2:1-3

But there were also false prophets among the people, just as there will be false teachers among you. They will secretly introduce destructive heresies, even denying the sovereign Lord who bought them—bringing swift destruction on themselves. ² Many will follow their depraved conduct and will bring the way of truth into disrepute. ³ In their greed these teachers will exploit you with fabricated stories. Their condemnation has long been hanging over them, and their destruction has not been sleeping.
