Arianism

READ: Colossians 2:9-10

⁹ For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form, ¹⁰ and in Christ you have been brought to fullness. He is the head over every power and authority.

THINK ABOUT IT: Why is this so important?

READ: DD- 126

READ: John 5:16-18

¹⁶ So, because Jesus was doing these things on the Sabbath, the Jewish leaders began to persecute him. ¹⁷ In his defense Jesus said to them, “My Father is always at his work to this very day, and I too am working.” ¹⁸ For this reason they tried all the more to kill him; not only was he breaking the Sabbath, but he was even calling God his own Father, making himself equal with God.

THINK DEEPER: What was the key problem with Arius’ teaching?

Remember... most heresy begins by focusing on or defending a truth but going to far!

Docetism

READ: Hebrews 2:17

¹⁷ For this reason he had to be made like them, fully human in every way, in order that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in service to God, and that he might make atonement for the sins of the people.

THINK ABOUT IT: Why is Jesus humanity so important?

READ: DD- 127

READ: Philippians 2:6-7

*⁶ Who, being in very nature God,
did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage;
⁷ rather, he made himself nothing
by taking the very nature of a servant,
being made in human likeness.*

THINK DEEPER: if you lean one way would it be towards Arianism or Docetism? Why?

 **Nestorianism**

READ: John 10:30

"I and the Father are one."

THINK ABOUT IT: What does it mean that the Father and Son are one?

READ: DD- 128

READ: John 5:19

John 5:19

"Jesus gave them this answer: "Very truly I tell you, the Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees his Father doing, because whatever the Father does the Son also does."

THINK DEEPER: How can verses like this lead us to believe that there is a divide between Jesus two natures, the divine and the human?

 **Eutychianism**

READ: Deuteronomy 6:4

"Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one."

THINK ABOUT IT: Why does Jesus need to have two natures?

READ: DD- 129

READ: Matthew 24:36

"But about that day or hour no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father."

THINK DEEPER: What does this tell us about the connection between Father and Son?

Calcedonian Definition

READ: Romans 1:3-4

"...regarding his Son, who as to his earthly life⁹ was a descendant of David,⁴ and who through the Spirit of holiness was appointed the Son of God in power by his resurrection from the dead: Jesus Christ our Lord."

THINK ABOUT IT: What does this tell you about Jesus nature?

READ: DD- 130

READ: John 1:18

"No one has ever seen God, but the one and only Son, who is himself God and is in closest relationship with the Father, has made him known."

THINK DEEPER: Why is it important to understand Jesus' nature and person?
