



LIFE GROUP DISCUSSION:

SHARE: When you think of generosity what comes to mind?

SHARE: Which best describes your relationship with money?
Spending, Savings, Accounting, Worry/Fear, Confusion, Generosity. Explain

READ: 2 Corinthians 9:6-11. How does believing in God's abundance change our attitude toward giving?

SHARE: Pastor Ken discussed how the serpent in Genesis painted God as stingy, leading to a scarcity mindset. How do you see this scarcity mindset affecting people's relationship with money today?

READ: Matthew 6:19-24. Are your eyes healthy or unhealthy when it comes to how you see God's provision and generosity?

DISCUSS: Looking at Jesus's miracles (water into wine, feeding of the 5000), how do these demonstrations of abundance challenge our modern attitudes toward generosity?

The sermon highlights how Jesus didn't just meet needs but exceeded them - making the best wine and having 12 baskets left over after feeding thousands. How might your giving change if you truly believed in God's abundant provision?

The sermon defines generosity as 'giving more than necessary or expected' and emphasizes that generosity is about our heart and perspective, not just our actions.

What areas of your life, beyond finances, could benefit from developing a more generous spirit?
