



LIFE GROUP DISCUSSION

SHARE: Where have you seen generosity make a difference?

READ: Mark 14:41-44. What does this teach us about God's perspective on generosity?

SHARE: Pastor Ken shared the story of Albert Lexi, who donated \$200,000 to the children's hospital from years of collecting tips from shoe shining. How does this story challenge our assumptions about who can be generous?

READ: 1 Timothy 6:17. How have you seen earthly wealth impact people negatively? What are some of the ways we put our hope in worldly wealth? How have you been impacted by the uncertainty of wealth?

SHARE: The sermon discusses the concept of a 'lifestyle cap' - not increasing your lifestyle as income increases. What are the spiritual and practical benefits of maintaining your current lifestyle even when you could afford more? What specific areas of your lifestyle might you need to cap to become more generous?

READ: 1 Timothy 6:18. What good deeds do you think would help point people to Jesus?

SHARE: Pastor Ken mentioned that 'God didn't put us here to make a living... He put us here to make a difference.' How might this perspective change the way we view our finances and possessions?

READ: 1 Timothy 6:19. What do you think it means to take hold of life that is truly life?

SHARE: What is one way you will plan to be generous this week?
