



LIFE GROUP DISCUSSION:

SHARE: What is one specific opportunity you've passed up that you now regret, and how might that influence your future decisions in following God's calling?

READ: Acts 21:4-15, Paul faces multiple warnings about going to Jerusalem, yet remains resolute. How can we distinguish between well-meaning advice and God's true direction for our lives?

SHARE: Pastor Ken mentioned that suffering and hardship aren't always signs that something is wrong, but might indicate we're disrupting the work of the evil one. How does this perspective challenge our common views about comfort and safety?

SHARE: What are some of the voices competing for your attention?

READ: MATTHEW 16:15-17 & 1-23, where Jesus rebukes Peter for having 'human concerns' rather than God's concerns. How can we ensure our advice to others comes from a godly perspective rather than worldly wisdom?

SHARE: The sermon mentioned that 90% of Americans would attend church if asked, yet many Christians resist sharing their faith. What barriers keep us from taking action on this opportunity?

Pastor Ken pointed out that often it's not the world that's resistant to the gospel, but rather Christians who are resistant to sharing it. What specific steps could you take this week to overcome your hesitation in sharing your faith with others?

READ: ACTS 20:24. What does Paul say is worth giving his life for? How would you answer the question... You may be willing to live for Jesus, but are willing to die for Him?
