UPWARD: (30min)

Acknowledge God for who He is....

Read: Psalm 8

- ¹ *Lord, our Lord,
how majestic is your name in all the earth! You have set your glory in the heavens.*
- ² *Through the praise of children and infants you have established a stronghold against
your enemies, to silence the foe and the avenger.*
- ³ *When I consider your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars,
which you have set in place,*
- ⁴ *what is mankind that you are mindful of them, human beings that you care for them?"*
- ⁵ *You have made them a little lower than the angels^v and crowned them with glory and
honor.*
- ⁶ *You made them rulers over the works of your hands; you put everything under their feet:*
- ⁷ *all flocks and herds, and the animals of the wild,*
- ⁸ *the birds in the sky, and the fish in the sea, all that swim the paths of the seas.*
- ⁹ *Lord, our Lord,
how majestic is your name in all the earth!*

Spend time praising God for who He is:

I will sing the praises of the name of the Lord Most High.*

*For the LORD is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues
through all generations*

INWARD: (30min)

Acknowledge anything that separates you from God. Repent and Confess your sins to God.

READ Psalm 139:23-24

²³ Search me, God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts.

²⁴ See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

READ 1 John 1:9-10

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. ¹⁰ If we claim we have not sinned, we make him out to be a liar and his word is not in us.

Spend time in confession:

(Consider writing your sins on a piece of paper and find a place to bury it)

READ Psalm 103: 8-12

⁸ The Lord is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in love.

⁹ He will not always accuse, nor will he harbor his anger forever;

¹⁰ he does not treat us as our sins deserve or repay us according to our iniquities.

¹¹ For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his love for those who fear him;

¹² as far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us.

Spend a few minutes thanking God for forgiving your sins through the blood of Jesus.
