- See every situation as an opportunity
- Reject comparison
- Be secure in your calling
- Find confidence in Christ

Philippians 1:18b-21 | NIV

Paul is confident in:

- The provision of the Spirit
- His deliverance
- His shamelessness
- His final destination

LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS

SHARE: On a scale of 1-10, how content would you rate yourself?

SHARE: Do you feel like your contentment has increased or decreased over the last 10 years? What has changed?

SHARE: Do you relate with the article that Devan read regarding Instagram Envy? Do you feel social media has contributed to a general lack of self-confidence?

Consider watching, *The Social Dilemma*, a documentary on Netflix highlighting how artificial intelligence in social media is contributing to the breakdown of society.

READ: Philippians 4:11-13

CONSIDER: How we define contentment is crucial for how we process this message series. Devan presented some alternate definitions of contentment, explaining what the word meant in relation to how Paul used it in this passage. For example, contentment is not stoicism, apathy, emotional monotony, a carefree or careless attitude, or passivity. What are some other ways Devan described contentment in light of Paul's life and writings?

READ: Philippians 1:12-18

DISCUSS: What are the evidences of Paul's contentment in this passage?

SHARE: Have you ever been emboldened by someone else's fearless leadership? Have you ever *been the leader*?

DISCUSS: What can we learn from Paul's refusal to worry about the false motives of these preachers?

READ: Philippians 1:18b-21

DISCUSS: Trace all the elements Paul was confident in.

SHARE: How does this passage challenge you to put your confidence in Jesus?

SHARE: Did you feel prompted to make a decision for Christ or renew your commitment to magnify Him with your life? If so, share with the group.
