LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS: WEEK 8

SHARE: About a time when you were really afraid of the dark? Why are we all typically afraid of the dark?

DISCUSS: Why do you think the Bible uses darkness as a metaphor for evil?

READ: Ephesians 5:1-2. What do you think it means here to, “Follow God’s example?”

READ: Ephesians 5:3-4. What does it mean to have a “hint” of the sins listed? How would you define immorality, impurity and greed?

READ: Ephesians 5:5. What do we forfeit when we ignore sinfulness in our life?

READ: Ephesians 5:6-7. This verse talks about “empty words.” What “empty words” have you heard? Where do they come from? How do they deceive people? What does it mean to be partners with them?

READ: Ephesians 5:8. What does it mean to you, to be a child of light?

READ: Ephesians 5:10. How do we, “Find out what pleases the Lord?”

READ: Ephesians 5:11-14. What deeds of darkness do you see visibly at work in our world today? How would we “expose” them?

DISCUSS / PLAN: How as a group could you call out a form of darkness and do something to expose it?

READ: Ephesians 5:15-17. What does it mean that, “the days are evil?” How do we discover what the Lord’s will is?”

READ: Ephesians 5: 18-20. What do these verses tell the follower of Christ to do?

SHARE: Spend some time “giving thanks to God.”
