



## WHERE'S YOUR TREASURE – WEEK 12 / MATTHEW 6:19-24

### LIFE GROUP DISCUSSION:

**READ: Matthew 6:19-20.** While most of us don't struggle with clinical hoarding, where do you see tendencies to accumulate and hold onto things in your own life? What fears or beliefs might be driving that behavior?

**READ: Matthew 6:21.** Jesus says, "Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." If someone examined your calendar and bank statements from the past month, what would they conclude your heart treasures most? Does that align with what you want to be true?

**READ: James 5:1-3 & 1 Timothy 6:17.** On a scale of 1-10, how much intentional thought and planning do you give to "storing up treasures in heaven" compared to planning your earthly financial future? What would it look like to be more strategic about eternal investments?

**READ: Matthew 6:22-23 & 1 John 2:15-17.** What influences—social media, advertising, friends' lifestyles, cultural messages—most affect how you "see" and what you desire? How can you develop healthier "eyes" that see from an eternal perspective?

**READ: Matthew 6:24.** In what areas of your life are you trying to "balance" serving God and serving money rather than choosing to serve God alone? What would it look like to stop balancing and start choosing?

**DISCUSS:** Do you have an intentional plan for investing your time, talents, and treasure in God's kingdom, or is your generosity mostly spontaneous? What would a planned, purposeful approach to kingdom investment look like for you in this season of life? What's your next concrete step?
