The task force brought its first report, with recommendations, to church council Dec. 15th. After discussion, motion passed to accept Pr. Michael's request to move from 3/4 time to 1/2 time. With these hours his main duties will center around Worship/Administration. He will continue to teach Confirmation and address other needs as they arise.

Visitation team has begun transitioning with Joyce Gilberts leading; she'll continue covering most visits. Pr. Michael's presence in worship over the course of the year will remain much the same as it's been since accepting our call in 2018. In-office hours will usually be Sundays, and Monday/Tuesday early mornings. As always, additional appointments can be scheduled.
