- Lydia, Dorcas, Phoebe, witnesses to the faith Women, as well as men were important Christian leaders from the beginning, as demonstrated by these coworkers of the apostle Paul. Lydia, a seller of purple goods, lent her home for a church; Dorcas was known for charitable works; Phoebe was a deacon in the church at Cenchrae.
- Thomas Aquinas, teacher, died 1274
 One of the most brilliant, creative theologians in the church's history, Aquinas worked to bring together scripture and Aristotle's philosophy. A member of the Order of Preachers (Dominicans), Aquinas was

also a hymn writer.
