COMMEMORATIONS

Philipp Nicolai, died 1608; Johann Heermann, died 1647; Paul Gerhardt, died 1676; Hymn writers

These great hymn writers all worked in 17th century Germany in times of war and plague.

Nicolai, a pastor, lost 1,300 parishioners to plague; 170 in one week. He wrote "O Morning Star, How Fair and Bright" and "Wake, Awake, For Night is Flving."

Heermann's hymns, including "Ah, Holy Jesus," often express the emotions of faith.

Gerhardt, perhaps the greatest Lutheran hymn writer, was a pastor in Berlin.
