COMMEMORATIONS

- Martín de Porres, renewer of society, died 1639 Son of a Spanish knight who freed a Black woman from Panama. As a lay brother in the Order of Preachers (Dominicans), he engaged in many charitable works in Lima, Peru. He founded an orphanage, hospital, and a clinic for cats/dogs.
- John Christian Frederick Heyer, died 1873;
- Bartholomaeus Ziegenbalg, died 1719;
- Ludwig Nommensen, died 1918; missionaries

Heyer was the 1st missionary sent out by American Lutherans. After teaching at Gettysburg College and Seminary he was assigned to the Andhra region of India. A worker among the Tamil people on the southeast coast of India, Ziegenbalg was opposed both by local Hindus and Danish authorities who favored a different missionary style. He was known for caring about the welfare of the whole person. Nommensen, born in northern Germany was sent to

Sumatra as a Lutheran missionary. Working among the Batak people, he translated the scriptures into their language, and honored their native culture.
